## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, two Tribal members Miss White Mountain Apache, Donna Rae Cooley and her Chaperone, Eileen Crocker wish to travel to Washington D.C. for the United National Indian Tribal Youth Conference to be held July 9-15, 1998 and have come before the Tribal Council requesting financial assistance from the Tribe to attend this Unity Conference; and

WHEREAS, these two individuals require \$446.00 for payment of their airfare; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Council is agreeable to donating \$446.00 for the purpose stated.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$446.00 from the Queen Committee account for their travel expenses to Washington, D.C. where they will attend the Unity Conference as representatives of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 18, 1998</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for <u>zero</u> against, and <u>one</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
