## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Sylvia Bones has come before the Tribal Council to request permission to obtain a lease for her homesite at Fort Apache; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Bones held a land assignment for the property which she has relinquished through the procedures set in place by the Tribal Land Board; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Bones needs the lease in order to pledge the leasehold interest as security for financing for her home at Fort Apache; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to authorize and grant her request, provided the necessary paperwork has been completed.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes a standard residential lease of 25 year term with an automatic 25 year renewal for Tribal member Sylvia Bones for the land Ms. Bones previously held under a land assignment.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to execute any documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution, provided he receives documentation to show all the necessary preliminary steps that have been taken to relinquish the land assignment, pursuant to Land Board rules and protocal, and that a survey and legal description of the premises are completed.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that if needed, directs that a survey of the leasehold premises be completed in order to carry out the lease request.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Tribal member Sylvia Bones to encumber the premises for the purpose of securing a loan through the Tribal Revolving Credit Program, the HUD 184 program or other lending program approved by the Tribal Council.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the encumbrance authorization shall be in effect for 120 days from the date of this resolution, and if no such approved encumbrance is put in effect before that time the authorization for the encumbrance shall be null and void.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the authorization for that home site lease is for the specific premises requested by the Tribal member Sylvia Bones and no other.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of eleven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (e), (f), (h), (i), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
