RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Janice Chilton has come before the Tribal Council to seek support for her effort to be elected to the Arizona House of Representatives from District IV; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Chilton, a member of the Colville Confederated Tribe of Washington, is the only Native American running for the District IV seat; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council wishes to support her candidacy and wishes to promote greater participation by Native Americans in state and federal political contests.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports and endorses the candidacy of Democrat Janice Chilton for the District IV seat in the Arizona House of Representatives.

The foregoing resolution was on May 13, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
