## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Hondah Casino & Convention Center has presented their fiscal year 98-99 budget to the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, funds were included in the capital budget to relocate the Hondah Mini Store to the east end and increase the size of the store; and
- WHEREAS, Roger Leslie, Hondah Management, requested the release of these funds to begin construction of the Hondah Mini Store; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is in agreement that the Hondah Mini Store should be relocated and increased in size and that the capital funds be released to begin construction.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the release of Hondah Casino & Convention Center's capital funds in the amount of \$1,082,224.00 for the purpose stated herein.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 1,1998</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for, <u>one</u> against and <u>one</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (1), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
