RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Eighteen Tribal members who are Alchesay High School students and members of the Alchesay High School Indian Club, have requested financial assistance to participate in the UNITY Conference in Washington, D.C., July, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that \$2,000.00 is the requested amount for meals; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that such educational experiences are in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache youth.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes \$2,000.00 for meals to assist members of the AHS Indian Club to participate in the UNITY Conference in Washington, D.C., July, 1998.

The foregoing resolution was on July 2, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (h), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
