FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, District IV Tribal Council Member of District IV, Mr. Herbert Tate, expressed concerns regarding the lack of progress of the Canyon Day Convenience Store; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Tate also stressed that the need for the store is great with the proposed construction of the new Canyon Day School; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussion, concludes that the three District IV Council delegates (Noland Clay, Mariddie J. Craig and Herbert Tate), along with Mr. Gerald Alsenay, General Manager of Apache Enterprises, be directed to coordinate their efforts towards progress of the Canyon Day Convenience Store.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the three District IV Council delegates, along with Mr. Gerald Alsenay, General Manager of Apache Enterprises, to coordinate their efforts towards progress of the Canyon Day Convenience Store.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
