WHEREAS, tribal member Margie Alo and spouse Lefty Alo have come before the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Tribal Council approve their small hardware/construction business with assistance from the TRU*SERV Coast to Coast organization; and

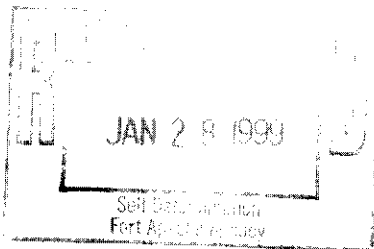
WHEREAS, they have identified the old Bowling Alley as their potential business site but were advised to locate another site as the tribe has future plans for the old Bowling Alley location; and

WHEREAS, they were advised the importance of being licensed and bonded; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports Mr. and Mrs. Alo's entrepreneurship and wish them well in their new business endeavor.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and encourages tribal member Margie Alo and spouse, Lefty Alo's entrepreneurship.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Sections (a), (b), (h), (o) (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
