FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

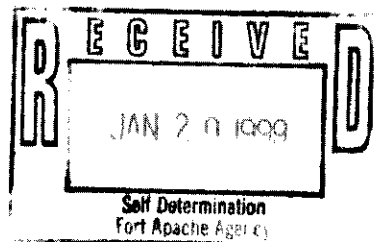
**WHEREAS**, Tribal member, Parker Kiva Loring whose birth date is April 29, 1984, and who is the son of Sylvester D. Loring and Lolita (Classay) Loring, has requested that his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished; and


**WHEREAS**, Mr. Loring is already enrolled with the Gila River Indian Community and wishes to remain on the Gila River Indian Community membership rolls.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request of Parker Kiva Loring effective this date.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Office of Vital Records to remove Parker Kiva Loring from the membership roll of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on July 22, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of six for and two against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
