RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Ruby Altaha, Revolving Credit Officer, has come before the Tribal Council this date with a status report regarding the Weatherization Program; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Altaha also informed the Tribal Council of the lack of communication between herself and Charlotte Bahlen, Weatherization Coordinator, although attempts have been made by Ms. Altaha; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussion, concludes that Chairman Massey should follow up with a written directive to Ms. Bahlen advising her that Ms. Altaha has direct supervision over Ms. Bahlen, including the Weatherization Program.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Chairman Massey to advise Ms. Bahlen, through a written directive that Ruby Altaha has supervisory authority over the Weatherization Program and the Weatherization Coordinator, Charlotte Bahlen.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 22, 1998</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
