**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received numerous requests from tribal members in all districts regarding problems with culvert drainage pipes; and

WHEREAS, the lack of culvert drainage pipes leads to flooding in residential areas; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recommends that the BIA conduct an engineering study and re-survey all culvert drainage pipes to correct the drainage problems in all communities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the BIA to conduct an engineering study and re-survey the culvert drainage pipe problems in all communities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
