**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, tribal member and Carrizo Community President, Janet Craig, has requested Tribal Council approval to utilize Carrizo Community Land Claim in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for a Back-to-School Party and to purchase school supplies for the school age children of Carrizo; and

WHEREAS, a petition to so use District II Carrizo Land Claims Funds for purposes stated is attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the petition request from the Carrizo Community to utilize Carrizo Land Claims Funds from District II in the amount of \$500.00 to sponsor a Back-to-School Party and to purchase school supplies for the school age children of Carrizo.

The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
