

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the funding for scholarships provided to eligible Tribal members enrolled in post-secondary education; and

WHEREAS, in light of increasing costs for college education the Council concludes that increases are needed for the scholarships, as set forth below.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves for immediate implementation the following scholarship levels for eligible Tribal members attending college or a university,


Freshmen Level	\$2,500 per semester
Sophomore Level	\$3,500 per semester
Junior Level	\$4,000 per semester
Senior Level	\$4,500 per semester


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the prior scholarship award levels are hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Director of Tribal Education Department to implement these scholarship levels and to enforce and uphold the eligibility and GPA guidelines under the Tribal Scholarship Program.

The foregoing resolution was on September 21, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
