RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Velma Martel, and non tribal member spouse, Buddy Martel, have come before the Tribal Council this date to request permission to provide a transit service from Whiteriver to Pinetop and Show Low, Arizona; and
- WHEREAS. Mr. & Mrs. Martel informed the Tribal Council that they are in the planning stages; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recommended that the Legal Department assist Mr. and Mrs. Martel with their proposal.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Legal Department to assist Mr. and Mrs. Martel with their proposal to provide a transit service.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of five for, zero against and one abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30,1 993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
