RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Wilma Taylor, has come before the Tribal Council this date and requests that the song "Baby, Baby", written and sung by her spouse, Kirk Taylor, Sr. be banned from being played on KNNB; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Taylor also stated that her and her children are being affected negatively from this song; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that they have removed certain types of harmful music from KNNB in the past and agree that for the well-being of Mrs. Taylor and her family, will ban the song "Baby, Baby" from KNNB.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby bans the playing of the song "Baby, Baby", written and sung by Kirk Taylor, Sr., on KNNB.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 2, 1998</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>two</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30,1 993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
