**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, the Oak Creek Livestock Association, represented by their Secretary, Naveen Dazen, has reorganized its governing board, revised its charter, held an association meeting and completed an inventory, as directed by the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, in exchange for completing its reorganization, the Tribal Council offered a one time payment of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) to the Association; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is satisfied that those reorganization steps have been completed.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a one-time payment of Ten Thousand Dollars, (\$10,000) to the Oak Creek Livestock Association, as agreed, for the completion by the Association of its reorganization.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
