

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Canyon Day Livestock Association has requested permission from the council to contract for the removal of feral horses from their livestock association district; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council consents to the removal of feral horses from the district; and


**WHEREAS**, the proposed agreement is between the district and the contractor only.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it consents to the request of the Canyon Day Livestock Association to hire an independent contractor to remove feral horses from the Canyon Day Livestock Association district and that such horses may be removed from the Reservation pursuant to terms worked out between the association and the independent contractor.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all activities of the contractor must be in compliance with Tribal law.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against and one abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (s) (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
