## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Neil Thompson, Chairman of the Northland Pioneer College Board has advised the Council that he is running for reelection to the Board; and
- WHEREAS, during his term on the Board, Mr. Thompson has worked with the Tribe and has given careful consideration for the needs of the Tribe in secondary education; and
- WHEREAS, through his efforts Mr. Thompson has secured funding to develop a new NPC campus within Whiteriver; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Thompson is best qualified to serve the interest of the Tribe and the region on the Northland Pioneer College Board.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it supports and endorses the candidacy of Neil Thompson for reelection to the Northland Pioneer College Board in the November, 1998, General Election.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 8, 1998</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
