RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Nelson Ethelbah, has come before the Tribal Council this date to inform the Tribal Council that his recycling business is family's sole income; and
- **WHEREAS**, tribal member, Priscilla Schroeder also wrote to the Tribal Council regarding her recycling business; and
- WHEREAS, they both expressed concerns that the Mountain Metals Recycling Company has affected their businesses financially; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Ethelbah and Mrs. Schroeder request assistance from the Tribal Council to cease allowing the Mountain Metals Recycling Company to operate in Whiteriver.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the request made by Mr. Ethelbah and Ms. White-Cooley and directs that the Mountain Metals Recycling Company cease all operations in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on October 7, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (1), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
