WHEREAS, Roads Committee Chairperson and Council Member Herbert Tate advises the Tribal Council that one of ADOT's projects is to expand highway 73 from Carrizo Junction to Canyon Day; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Tate explained the necessity of widening this highway; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the importance of improving and widening Highway 73 for the safety of motorists and highly supports this project.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the expansion of Highway 73 from Carrizo Junction to Canyon Day and further supports the efforts of Roads Committee Chairperson and Council Member Herbert Tate, and ADOT in this expansion project.

The foregoing resolution was on October 22, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30,1 993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
