RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Dino Manual, the Whiteriver community president, has come before the Tribal Council to request monetary assistance for Christmas festivities; and
- WHEREAS, it is recommended that the funding be provided from the 22-D General Land Claims fund account for the Whiteriver community; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the benefit of using those funds for the well-being of the entire community during this holiday season.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the award of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) from the 22-D General Land Claims Fund for Whiteriver Community Christmas activities.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and delegates authority to the Tribal Treasurer to review and process the request for payment or reimbursement by duly authorized members of the Whiteriver Community officers, subject to the accounting and disbursement standards for use of the 22-D funds.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 2, 1999</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (e), (g), (h), (i), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
