The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 3, 1998</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
