WHEREAS, the Tribal Council consents to the removal of feral horses from the management area; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement to include input from Joe Harvey, I.D. Manager and Candy Lupe, Wetlands Planner.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a contract to remove feral horses from the ID Range management area.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 22, 1998</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (f), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30,1 993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
