

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal member Kathy Bragg has come before the Council this day to ask for assistance in restoring her home following several unfortunate break-ins and acts of vandalism; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Bragg needs assistance in getting clothing for her family, repairs to damage to the home, and security lighting and fencing to prevent further acts of vandalism and robbery; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Bragg also request assistance in obtaining information from the Housing Authority concerning insurance coverage available for her loss.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Social Services department to assist Ms. Bragg in obtaining any emergency funding to which she may be entitled and in assisting her in obtaining clothing and any home furnishings she needs which were lost due to break-ins.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs the Housing Authority to provide any assistance available to Ms. Bragg for which she may be eligible including repairs of damage to her residence, provisions for security lighting and security fencing on her premises, and a determination whether any of her losses are covered under insurance policies maintained by the Housing Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Council member Mariddie Craig shall assist in advising the family on community resources available to them to improve their residence.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (e), (h), (i), (j), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
