

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, Linda DeClay, Tribal Education Director, with recommendations from the Scholarship Review Committee, has proposed the 1999 Spring Semester Tribal Scholarship Allocations; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is in agreement with the proposed 1999 Spring Semester Tribal Scholarship Allocations as presented; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby implements the following scholarship levels for eligible Tribal members attending colleges or universities as recommended by the Scholarship Review Committee:

Freshmen Level	\$2,700 per semester
Sophomore Level	\$2,800 per semester
Junior Level	\$3,100 per semester
Senior Level	\$3,300 per semester
Masters	\$4,500 per semester
Ph.D.	\$6,000 per semester
Law	\$6,000 per semester
Medicine	\$7,000 per semester

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
