FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**



WHEREAS, these programs offer a system in which schools and workplaces work together in order to prepare students to achieve at their highest potentials; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that both programs are beneficial for our tribal members and give support for both programs.

The foregoing resolution was on January 8, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
