## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Darrell Parker, and his son Tony have come before the Tribal Council to report that Tony has been selected to play football in Germany with the USA Junior National Team: and
- **WHEREAS.** Mr. Parker is planning fund raising activities to raise money for the expenses of the trip; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Parker has requested assistance from the Tribal Council in providing funds to help pay for the trip; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council congratulates Tony Parker on his hard work and success which has made him a role model for youth in the community; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it is appropriate to contribute to the efforts of a Tribal member who has distinguished himself; and
- WHEREAS, it is an established guideline that under limited circumstances, Tribal Council can provide up to \$500 to qualifying Tribal member requests for travel expenses for worthwhile activities.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby congratulates Tony Parker for his selection to the USA Junior National Team to play football in Germany.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby awards a contribution of \$500 to Tony Parker's fund raising efforts to help cover his travel expenses.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 3, 1999</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
