

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council recognizes that education is a high priority for the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, many colleges and universities are utilizing on-line research through the internet; and

**WHEREAS**, the Higher Education Coordinator has recommended to the Tribal Council that the Higher Education Department establish a computer lab to teach students the fundamentals of on-line research so they will have a working knowledge of computer research while preparing for and attending college; and

**WHEREAS**, a computer network system would also enable the Higher Education Department to store and categorize information on student financial and statistical data; and

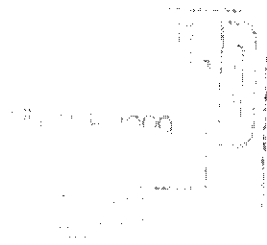
**WHEREAS**, the Higher Education Department has requested that the Tribal Council authorize funding to purchase computer equipment for a computer research lab and department data storage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council concurs that computer equipment would be highly beneficial in preparing students for college and for department record keeping.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$5,000.00 to purchase computer equipment for a computer lab for the Higher Education Department.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it directs the Higher Education Department to coordinate the purchase of the computer equipment and programs through the Tribal Computer Department.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
