

**RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

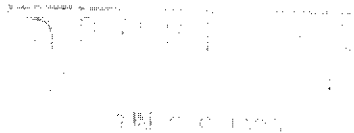
WHEREAS, Tribal member Cecelia Alchesay informed the Tribal Council this date that, although she is currently renting a housing unit at Ben Gay, the rent is high; and

WHEREAS, she has a Self Help Home which she transferred to relatives and now is ineligible for a HIP home as the home is still in her name; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed regarding Ms. Alchesay's housing situation and agrees that she be given consideration within the HIP Housing Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby acknowledges Ms. Cecelia Alchesay's housing need and that she be given consideration within the HIP Housing Program.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
