- WHEREAS, Herbert Tate, Roads Committee Chairperson and Vernon Palmer, Phoenix Area Roads Office, have presented a roads update to the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, many road related concerns and costs were identified for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council directs Vernon Palmer of the Phoenix Area Roads Office to seek and secure more funding for roads maintenance on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports and directs Vernon Palmer to seek and secure more funding for roads maintenance on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 4, 1999</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30,1 993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
