

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Tribe has, through the development and continued support of the Apache Culture Center and Museum, sought to preserve the history and perpetuate the culture of the White Mountain Apache people; and

WHEREAS, Nohwiké Bágowa the Apache Culture Center and Museum seeks to develop programs, exhibits and education materials that will educate local, national and international audiences about Apache culture and history; and seeks to build its audience based by offering regular changing exhibits; and


WHEREAS, Cindy Burnette, a White Mountain Apache Tribal member currently serving a fellowship in museum practices at the School of American Research (SAR) in Santa Fe, has proposed to develop an exhibit of Apache materials from the SAR collection from Nohwiké Bágowa.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it authorizes and endorses the development of a jointly planned exhibit between the SAR and the Apache Culture Center, utilizing a combination of grant funds and Apache Culture Center and SAR resources, thereby providing an opportunity to present rarely seen historical objects of Apache material to the local community and encouraging community involvement in cultural preservation and perpetuation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the development of grant and other financial assistance proposals to be submitted to funding agencies, including the Arizona Commission on the Arts, the Arizona Humanities Council and other sources in support of the development of this exhibit.

The foregoing resolution was on March 4, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (i), (j), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
