## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has in executive session this day, reviewed and heard the reason for termination of employment from Chaghache Day Care Center as stated by Raynor Gushoney Sr.; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council has considered all the evidence and discussion presented on the grounds for the termination; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Gushoney should be given the opportunity to return to work.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reinstates Raynor Gushoney Sr., to his position and former rate of pay with the Chaghache Day Care Center.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Raynor Gushoney Sr. be reinstated at Chaghache Day Care Center.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 7, 1999</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against with <u>ONE</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
