

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, tribal member, Melanie Perida Ramon whose birth date is 02/13/69, and who is the daughter of Benedict E. Ramon and Ollie Jane Dunlap has requested that her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that she may become eligible for enrollment in the Tohono O'Odham Tribe; and


WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights was signed by Melanie Perida Ramon in the presence of a Notary Public on the 9th day of April, 1999 and are attached hereto.

WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee approved this relinquishment request at their meeting on April 16, 1999.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request of Melanie Perida Ramon, and her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is granted relinquished this date.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Office of Vital Records to remove Melanie Perida Ramon from the membership roll of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article II, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
