

**Resolution No. 06-99-124**

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Governing Body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has authorized the Tribal Health Authority Executive Director to develop, plan, negotiate, execute and administer health services and preventative education; and

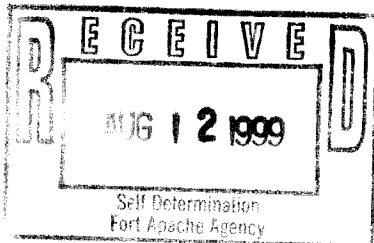
**WHEREAS,** the Fort Apache Indian Reservation population has increased resulting in a greater demand for delivery of health services, new and expanded programs and associated funding; and

**WHEREAS,** the administrative organizational structure has remained unchanged for the past 20 years while the number of health programs and funding sources have almost tripled; and


**WHEREAS,** additional programs and funding have become necessary to better serve the residents of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation while additional management and administrative support is greatly needed to assist with grant/contract development, quality assurance, financial management of all funding sources and overall supervision of 128 Health Authority employees.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes a change in the organizational structure of the Tribal Health Authority Management Unit to include four new positions: Deputy Director, Financial Officer, Administrative Officer and Planner to accommodate the increasing population growth, demand for new services and improve the overall quality assurance of all Tribal Health Authority Programs.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for, ZERO against and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (d), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
