

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency, has furnished custodial and utility services at the Whiteriver Fire Management Center, pursuant to a Memorandum of Agreement with the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, said Memorandum of Agreement expired October 1, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has submitted for approval a Memorandum of Agreement to continue providing custodial and utility services at this location for another term beginning October 1, 1998 and ending September 30, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Maintenance Department was provided an opportunity to furnish custodial services at this location, but declined to take on this responsibility at this time due to insufficient personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves this Memorandum of Agreement in the form attached hereto, and further requests that an opportunity be provided for tribal members to submit bids to contract these services, for any future renewal of the Memorandum of Agreement.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a Memorandum of Agreement with the BIA Fort Apache Agency, for a term beginning October 1, 1998 and ending September 30, 1999, in the form attached hereto, for the premises known as the Whiteriver Fire Management Center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that tribal members shall also be provided an opportunity to submit bids to contract custodial services for the premises, for any future renewals of the MOA.



The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Seciton 1(a), (b), (e), (h), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This agreement entered into between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency, designates the terms and conditions under which services as Whiteriver Fire Management Center, Whiteriver, Arizona are to be accomplished by Bureau of Indian Affairs and paid for by the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

1. In accordance with the Participation Schedule, the Bureau of Indian Affairs shall be reimbursed, not to exceed \$46,000.00, for custodial and utility services performed at the location designated herein. Payments will be made on a quarterly basis beginning on or about October 1, 1998.
2. On a quarterly basis, the Bureau of Indian Affairs shall submit to the White Mountain Apache Tribe an itemized invoice for payment.
3. Should there be a complaint of unsatisfactory service, the White Mountain Apache Tribe shall inform the Bureau of Indian Affairs Superintendent. The Bureau of Indian Affairs shall investigate the complaint and respond to the White Mountain Apache Tribe within two (2) weeks.
4. Reimbursement for the services identified herein shall be contingent upon the satisfactory performance of the services provided by the BIA, and subject to the Tribe's receipt of funding from GSA for said services.

This **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT** shall be effective for a period beginning October 1, 1998 and ending September 30, 1999, subject to amendment by mutual consent and termination upon written request by either party.
