FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has in Regular Council Meeting this day, reviewed and heard the grievance appeal submitted by Ludy Altaha from the Whiteriver Restaurant; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered all the evidence and discussions presented on the grounds for the grievance; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Ms. Altaha should be given the opportunity to return to work immediately.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reinstates Ludy Altaha to her position and former rate of pay with the Whiteriver Restaurant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ludy Altaha be reinstated with full benefits, back pay from termination date to present, annual and sick leave be accrued up to date, and retroactive reinstatement of health and retirement benefits if Ms. Altaha had been a participant in these programs prior to her release from employment.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and two against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
