

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has in Regular Council meeting this day, reviewed and heard the grievance appeal submitted by Patricia Nosie from the Whiteriver Police Department; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has considered all the evidence and discussions presented on the grounds for the grievance; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that Mrs. Nosie should be given the opportunity to return to work immediately.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reinstates Patricia Nosie to her position and former rate of pay with the Whiteriver Police Department.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Patricia Nosie be reinstated with full benefits, back pay from termination date, May 28, 1999, to present, annual and sick leave be accrued up to date, and retroactive reinstatement of applicable health and retirement benefits, if Ms. Nosie had been a participant in these programs prior to her release from employment.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
