

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, the Tribal Emergency Response Commission (TERC), established in accordance with the federal Superfund Amendments Reauthorization Act by Tribal law through Chapter One of the Tribal Environmental Code for the purpose of providing a central coordinating group within the Tribe to prepare for and respond to hazardous materials, accidents and spills, and other emergencies such as fire and flooding, is chaired by the Chief of the Whiteriver Fire and Rescue Department and has been holding monthly meetings for the past two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, the TERC has developed an "Emergency Response Notification Chart and List" (attached), to clarify roles and responsibilities of all parties during emergency response to improve coordination, response time, and to provide for a more effective response overall; and


WHEREAS, the TERC seeks endorsement by the Tribal Council of the attached "Emergency Response Notification Chart and List", including revisions and amendments necessary to keeping the Chart current and effective.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses the attached "Emergency Response Notification Chart and List" and authorizes members of the TERC and cooperating agencies and partners to fully implement this notification structure to provide for more effective emergency response.

The foregoing resolution was on July 15, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
