

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** Mr. & Mrs. Joe and Myrtle Bragg have come before the Tribal Council to request permission to operate a tow truck service from their business site adjacent to the TreeTop Auto Body Shop; and

**WHEREAS,** the Braggs have informed the Tribal Council that the Police Department and other public agencies frequently need an additional tow truck service, as the other tow truck service in Whiteriver is often unavailable; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. & Mrs. Bragg have purchased a tow truck which they plan to have certified by ADOT within the next week for use upon the state roadways; and

**WHEREAS,** the tow truck would also carry the necessary insurance coverage and would have access to customers by cellular telephone service; and

**WHEREAS,** the permission to conduct this service should be formalized in a Council Resolution and Business Permit, as well as an addendum to the business site lease between the Tribe and Joe Coppedge, dba TreeTop Auto Body, as the Braggs proposed activities would occur within those leased premises.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request by Mr. & Mrs. Joe and Myrtle Bragg to operate a tow truck service within the Reservation, subject to the conditions above.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs the Legal Department to prepare a permit agreement authorizing the tow truck service and setting forth the conditions indicated above.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes an addendum to the lease between the Tribe and Joe Coppedge, dba TreeTop Auto Body to allow for the tow truck services authorized under this Resolution to occur within the referenced business leased premises.


