## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Janet Craig, by previous Resolution No. 03-98-36, obtained Tribal Council approval for a residential lease for her home site which is located in Hondah Homesites-B Section and identified in Exhibit A attached hereto; and
- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 03-98-36 also granted Janet Craig permission to encumber the premises for a period not to exceed 180 days from the date of said resolution, for the purpose of securing a loan through the Tribal Revolving Credit Program or other financial institution; and
- WHEREAS, the 180-day period granted Janet Craig to encumber the premises has lapsed, and Mrs. Craig is requesting Tribal Council approval for an extension to enable her to secure financing for her home.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extends authorization to Janet Craig to encumber the premises located at Hondah Homesites B-Section, more fully identified in Exhibit A attached hereto, for the purpose of securing a loan to finance the purchase of her home.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this extension shall be approved for an additional 180-day period, effective the date of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 12, 1999</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (b), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,1934 (48 Stat. 984).
