

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Land Restoration Code states that a portion of the Permanent Land Restoration Fund be set aside for Scholarships and Internships for upper-level Tribal Member college students pursuing a degree in Natural Resources or a related field; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Land Restoration Board met on Friday, July 23, 1999, to review three scholarship applications; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Land Restoration Board selected the following students for scholarship awards for the fall semester of 1999: Doreen Gatewood (University of Arizona, Master's Program in Renewable Natural Resources), Colbert Burnette, (Northern Arizona University, Civil Engineering Program) and Jonathan Cody (Stanford University, Master's Program in Water Resources Engineering); and

WHEREAS, scholarship selections were based on completeness of application by the deadline, merit, and priority was given to those students who possess a demonstrated commitment to caring for the Tribe's land and culture.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses the Tribal Land Restoration Board's selection of the above scholarship recipients for the fall semester of 1999.

The foregoing resolution was on August 13, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SIX and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (1), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1933 (48 Stat. 984).
