

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS**, the White Mountain Apache Tribe operates the Housing Improvement Program under a P. L. 93-638 contract; and
- WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has revised its funding methodology and distribution of HIP funds for the fiscal year 2000 appropriations; and
- WHEREAS**, the new Bureau of Indian Affairs' methodology requires that Indian tribes complete and submit a listing of all eligible HIP applicants before funds can be released; and
- WHEREAS**, the White Mountain Apache Tribal HIP staff has completed the required work plan and the report of accomplishments; and
- WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Indian Affairs requires a tribal resolution to confirm the accuracy and completeness of the information submitted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that while there is a tremendous need for HIP housing and the inventory does not truly reflect this need, the data submitted by the Tribal Housing Improvement staff is accurate and complete.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the HIP work plan and report of accomplishment be submitted to the BIA for the distribution of FY 2000 HIP appropriation.

The foregoing resolution was on August 13, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SIX and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (c), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1933 (48 Stat. 984).
