RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by resolution directed the Tribal Council Secretary to post the proposed amendments to the Environmental Code in each district for a minimum of 10 days as required by the Construction of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Council Secretary advised the Tribal Council that said proposed Ordinance No. 217 has been posted in accordance with the directive; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council having received no opposition to the proposed amendments to the Environmental Code concludes that Ordinance No. 217 entitled Chapter Three, Water Quality Protection of the White Mountain Apache Tribe should be enacted.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No. 217, adding Chapter Three, Water Quality Protection to the Environmental Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Law and Order Code.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 1, 1999</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (q), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
