RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member and Pathways Coordinator, Becky Ethelbah has approached the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Tribal Council approve Pathways manuscript for publication, titled, "Weight Loss Attitudes Toward Body Size, Eating and Physical Activity in American Indian children: Relationship to Weight and Gender; and
- WHEREAS, this report examines dieting, weight perception, self-efficacy and their relationships to weight status and gender among American Indian elementary schoolchildren; and
- WHEREAS, this manuscript examines data collected as part of the baseline Pathways study and data is collected from American Indian children in 41 schools who filled out a questionnaire and had heights and weights taken; and
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves publication of Pathways manuscript titled, "Weight Loss Attitudes Toward Body Size, Eating and Physical Activity in American Indian Children: Relationship to Weight and Gender."

The foregoing resolution was on October 13, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1933 (48 Stat. 984).
