FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

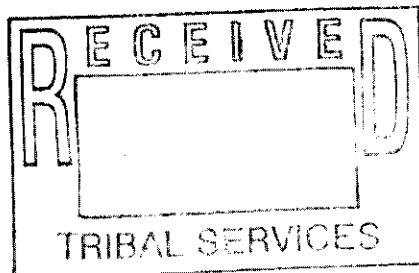
WHEREAS, the Chief of Police Raymond Burnette has come before the Tribal Council this date and has informed them of the need for new dispatch equipment for the Whiteriver Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the new dispatch equipment is approximately \$13,400.00; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that new dispatch equipment is essential for the Whiteriver Police Department.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the purchase of the new dispatch equipment for the Whiteriver Police Department.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
