

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council has this day discussed the operations of the Smoke Shop at Hon-Dah as well as other private commercial operations within the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council would like to see copies of the business records from the Smoke Shop to make sure the business is paying the appropriate business fees to the Tribal Government; and
- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council will also review business lease arrangements for other business operations; and
- WHEREAS**, for this reason, the Tribal Council needs to see Smoke Shop business records which identify the gross revenue of the business, years of operation, the identity of the business partners, and the payments to the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS**, these records must be delivered immediately to the Tribe to show the role of part owner Ronnie Lupe in the business to answer questions the public may have about his business activities; and
- WHEREAS**, Mr. Lupe has filed papers showing his intent to run for Tribal Council for District I; and
- WHEREAS**, the public has the right to hear about his business activities in considering his run for office; and
- WHEREAS**, these records should be available immediately and are needed by the Tribe to regulate business activities within the Reservation.

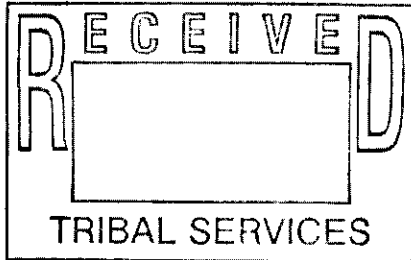
**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Ronnie Lupe to provide to the Tribal Council, through the office of the Tribal Treasurer, within ten (10) days of the date of this Resolution, business records for the Smoke Shop at Hon-Dah which shows the payments the business made to the Tribe, the owners of the business, the years of operation, and the annual gross revenue.


