

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

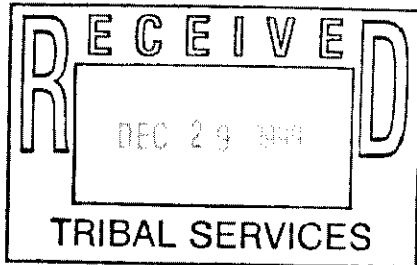
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe enacted a Road Construction Priority List in Resolution No. 03-99-49 which requires that ten percent of the annual allocation be utilized toward surface sealing; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has requested that the Tribe prioritize a list of surface sealing project.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby amends Resolution No. 03-99-49 to include the attached prioritized surface sealing projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that all other provisions of Resolution No. 03-99-49 shall remain in effect.

The foregoing resolution was on December 8, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
