WHEREAS, Mr. Craig was invited as a guest speaker to share his wisdom and experience as a young father; and

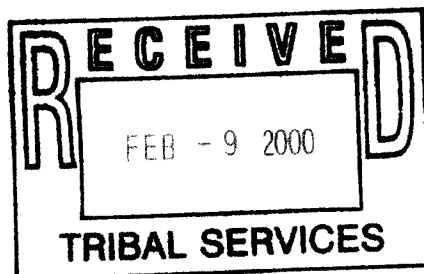
WHEREAS, although \$500.00 was originally requested to assist Mr. Craig with his travel, Health Authority assisted him with only \$300.00; and


WHEREAS, other Tribal Members have been assisted with \$500.00 when traveling out of state and in all fairness, Mr. Craig should receive an additional \$200.00; and


WHEREAS, the \$200.00 to be paid from the Tribe's consultant line item account.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves \$200.00 to be paid to Dustinn Craig from the Tribe's consultant line item account.

The foregoing resolution was on January 14, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for, ZERO against and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
