

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

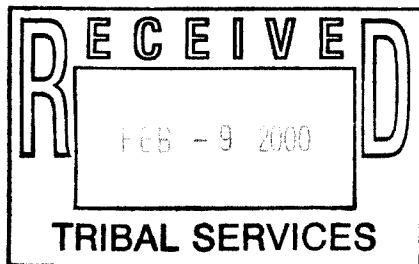
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous resolution directed the Tribal Council Secretary to post Ordinance No. 218, which proposes revisions to Chapter One and Two of the Criminal Code, in each district for a minimum of ten days as required by the Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Council Secretary advised the Tribal Council that said proposed Ordinance has been posted in accordance with that directive; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council having received no opposition to Ordinance No. 218, concludes that the proposed amendments to Chapters One and Two of the Criminal Code should be enacted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No. 218, amending Chapters One and Two of the White Mountain Apache Criminal Code.

The foregoing resolution was on January 14, 2000 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
