- WHEREAS, Article VI of the Tribal Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe requires regular elections to be held for Tribal Council Members; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VI, Section 8 of the Tribal Constitution, the Tribal Council adopted an Election Ordinance which mandates that a Primary Election be held on the first Wednesday of February during an election year, established by Article VI, Section 1 of the Tribal Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, said Primary Election was held by the White Mountain Apache Tribe on Wednesday, February 02, 2000, wherein Tribal Council candidates submitted their names to a vote of the people for Council Offices in Districts I and III; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission has certified to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Primary Election is complete and has been carried out in accordance with provisions of the Tribal Constitution and the Election Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and has certified that of the total of 1.191 ballots cast, the following number of votes were received by the individuals listed below whose names were on the ballot for the following offices:


