RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, by virtue of the powers listed in the Tribal Constitution and the Tribal Council's inherent authority to appropriate tribal funds for tribal purposes and to regulate its own procedures and to act on matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Whiteriver Assembly of God church has requested \$500 in assistance from Tribal Council Member Mariddie Craig of District IV to defray expenses for 38 people to travel on a missions trip to Mexico on February 18-21; and
- WHEREAS, Council Member Mariddie Craig has advised the Tribal Council of her desire to assist the Whiteriver Assembly of God by donating \$500 from her travel expense account, and the Tribal Council believes that the outreach of Tribal members to people in Mexico is a worthwhile donation.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby permits Council Member Mariddie Craig to allocate \$500 from her travel expense account to the Whiteriver Assembly of God to help defray the travel expense for 38 Tribal members to travel to Mexico to reach out to people less fortunate.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 9, 2000</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
